Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be an undergraduate or graduate student within the last 3 months of application submission.
- Have completed or be actively working on an engineering project focused on hydrocephalus.
- Be a member of the Hydrocephalus Association Network for Discovery Science.

- Design summary of project (1-2 pages, single-spaced, Arial font, 11 pt.)
 - Describe the project in detail, including a title, introduction, methodology, and results/evaluation. Projects will be scored based on innovation and scientific merit. Figures are optional.
 - Include references for design summary on a separate page(s).
- Personal statement (1/2 page, single-spaced, Arial font, 11 pt.)
- CV
- Letter of support from faculty mentor

Award winners will have the opportunity to be matched with an engineering faculty mentor, providing the opportunity for increased networking and mentorship. This program is optional. Please indicate on the application if you wish to participate.
